- **Barry M. Goldwater Scholarship** Created to award study in the fields of mathematics, the natural sciences and engineering, the scholarship will cover eligible expenses for tuition, fees, books, and room and board up to a maximum of \$7500 annually.

 These scholarships for students on Pell Grants encourage participation in a broad range of fields of study in a wide range of countries. Students can apply for study abroad for an academic year, semester or short-term program.
- [Morris K. Udall Scholarships](#) Scholarships provide up to \$5,000, or the cost of tuition, fees, books, room and board, whichever is less, to sophomores and juniors who have demonstrated a strong academic record and outstanding potential for leadership. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of merit to two groups of students; those who study the environment or related fields, and those with Native American or Native Alaskan backgrounds who study health care or tribal public policy.
- [Harry S. Truman Scholarship](#) Awarded on the basis of merit to students who will be college seniors and who wish to pursue graduate study in public service fields. Covers eligible expenses for tuition, fees, books, and room and board, up to \$3000 a year for undergraduate education and \$30,000 for graduate studies. An applicant must be a full-time junior level student at the time of application.
