The UNCW Office of Cultural Arts, in partnership with local and regional organizations, present "Let Your Children Tell", performed by the Touring Theater Ensemble of North Carolina. **Two exclusive school performances will be presented for high school students at UNCW's Kenan Auditorium on Monday, April 28th as part of Days of Remembrance**, a week-long commemoration featuring music, art, dance, film and dialogue about the Holocaust. "Let Your Children Tell" is a riveting one hour play is based on the actual experiences of three young people in Europe during the Holocaust -- Jewish and gypsy (Roma) -- who struggle to survive physically and emotionally under Nazi tyranny.

Written by North Carolina playwright and producer Brenda Schleunes with support from the N.C. Council on the Holocaust, "Let Your Children Tell" has been presented to high school and college classes across the state.

Performances will be held on Monday, April 28, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. and 11 a.m. Reservations are required. Seating is limited. Schools will be confirmed on a first-come, first-serve basis; therefore you are encouraged to register as soon as possible. Please see below for more details.

We do not issue hard tickets. A confirmation e-mail will be sent to you within two weeks of order receipt. If the show requested is sold out, you will be placed on a waiting list and notified if seats become available. Please be certain to register for enough seats for all students, chaperones, and teachers attending. Minor adjustments to reservations will be accommodated, up to three weeks prior to the show, if seating is available.

Because these performances are free, seats are only guaranteed once the confirmation email is sent. If you reserve tickets, please honor your commitment. If you must cancel, please do so at least one month prior to the performance date, so that seats can be given to groups on the waiting list.
