## TEACHING ABOUT THE HOLOCAUST:

A Workshop for Middle and High School Teachers in Southeastern N.C.

The UNCW Office of Cultural Arts and N.C. Council on the Holocaust present "Teaching about the Holocaust", a teacher workshop for the region's middle and high school teachers. This workshop is presented as part of UNCW's *Days of Remembrance*, a week long commemoration featuring music, art, dance, film and dialogue about the Holocaust.

"Teaching About the Holocaust" is a day-long workshop that will be held at the UNCW Watson School of Education. The conference features guest speakers Gizella Abramson, a survivor of the Maidanek death camp in Poland; and Holocaust scholar Dr. Karl Schleunes, chair of the History Department at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro and author of *The Twisted Road to Auschwitz* and *Legislating the Holocaust: The Nuremberg Laws*.

**The workshop will be held on April 2, 2008 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Substitute pay will be provided for all public school teachers attending.**
