SUBJECT: Seasonal Flu Vaccination Clinic

This fall there will be two flu vaccines available – the seasonal flu vaccine and the H1N1 vaccine. It is recommended that people receive both vaccines. Information about the availability and timing of the H1N1 vaccine is not available yet. We expect to have more details in early October. This letter provides the details of how to get the seasonal flu vaccine.

For your convenience and good health, UNC Wilmington has partnered with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of North Carolina (BCBSNC) and Maxim Health Systems to host a SEASONAL flu vaccination clinic on campus again this year.

The vaccinations are free of charge to individuals who are covered by **BlueCross/Blue Shield of North Carolina**, or **Medicare Part B** health insurances. Students covered by these insurances are also eligible. For those not covered by these insurances and who still wish to receive the vaccination, there will be a charge of \$30.00 (cash or check).

Dates: Thursday, October 15, 2009 and Tuesday, November 17, 2009
Time: 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Location: Burney Center

The vaccine can be administered to individuals age nine and over. (Children under age nine must receive shots from their primary care physician). Please note that prior to receiving the vaccination, individuals will be required to present their insurance ID card (in the plans noted above), a photo ID, and to sign a consent form.
