

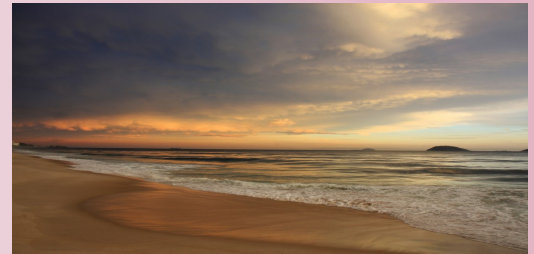

- Fall charges are not posted to the student account until July 18, 2012.
- Fall 2012 pre-registration E-bills will be generated on July 18, 2012 and are due on August 6, 2012.
- Students and Authorized Users will receive an e-mail when the E-bill is available.
- **Students registering after August 17, 2012 will receive a bill with a due date of August 30, 2012.**
