SUBJECT: Call for Nominations: Hoggard Medal for Achievement

Purpose	The Office of the Provost seeks nominations for the Hoggard Medal for Achievement.
About the Hoggard Medal for Achievement	The Hoggard Medal for Achievement, presented through the generosity of the late Dr. John T. Hoggard, is awarded annually to the graduating senior who, in the opinion of the faculty, has shown the most improvement during their years at the university.
Eligibility	All seniors graduating in August 2022, December 2022, and May 2023 are eligible for nomination.
Award Criteria	As you consider potential students to nominate for this award, please know that this award recognizes not only improvements in academic achievement, but also challenges or adversity that the student may have overcome during their time at UNCW.
Nomination Process	If you wish to nominate a student, please submit a letter of nomination stating why your nominee should receive this award. Nominations should be sent to the Office of the Provost and Academic Affairs via email to Dr. Carol Ellis (ellispc@uncw.edu) by Thursday, March 2, 2023 .
Selection Process	An anonymous committee of the faculty will review all nominations and select the student who, in their opinion, best fits the criteria for the award. The recipient will be announced during the annual Celebration of Senior Excellence, which takes place in conjunction with the spring commencement ceremonies.
