<sup>5</sup>(Arts/Humanities III); student can any course from Arts/Humanities I or II that they haven't previously taken

<sup>6</sup>Communications (Required Courses); student can take COM 110, COM 120 or COM 231

<sup>7</sup>If student graduated high school more than 7 years ago or is taking a different language than studied in high school, they can take another course in the Global Awareness & FL category. If student graduated high school within last 7 years or is taking same language as high school or did not have at least two foreign language courses in high school, then they must take FL through 201 level.
