#### Recommended Applied Music and Ensemble

Four semesters of applied and/or ensemble are recommended. Students should plan to enroll in two additional hours of either at UNCW if unable to complete four of each within the AFA degree.

#### Proficiencies in Music Theory, Piano and Applied Music

Incoming transfer students will take proficiency exams in music theory, and piano in order to determine placement level, if necessary. Students will be advised following the entrance audition and theory placement exam, if a lower level applied, and/or repeating lower level music theory is recommended.
