The University of North Carolina at Wilmington **strongly recommends** students complete their Associate's degree prior to transferring to UNCW. Pathways are structured for students who have completed all requirements for their Associate's degree and qualify for the CAA. UNCW recommends that transfer students complete the Foreign Language Requirements prior to enrolling at UNCW.

<sup>1</sup>(Social/Behavioral Science I); student is required to take 9 credits from at least two different disciplines: HIS 111, HIS 112, HIS 131, HIS 132, ECO 251, ECO 252, POL 120, PSY 150 or SOC 210.

<sup>2</sup>Communications (Arts/Humanities); student is required to take COM 120 or COM 231.

<sup>3</sup>(Arts/Humanities); student is required to take 6 credits from: ART 111, ART 114, ART 115, DRA 111, MUS 110, MUS 112, ENG 231, ENG 232, ENG 241, ENG 242, PHI 215, PHI 240.

<sup>4</sup>If student graduated high school more than 7 years ago **or** is taking a different language than studied in high school, they can take another course in the Additional General Ed category at the community college. If student graduated high school within last 7 years and is taking same language as high school or did not have at least two foreign language courses in high school, then they must take the same FL through 201 level at the CC or at UNCW. UNCW recommends that transfer students complete the Foreign Language Requirements prior to enrolling at UNCW. A student who chooses to wait on the FL requirement should consult with their advisor about satisfying the FL requirement at UNCW.

**THIS SHEET IS FOR ADVISING PURPOSES ONLY.** Students should work with their Advisor to determine course selections that will result in the greatest transferrable credit, for the intended program, upon transfer to the four-year school. Please remember that C-'s do not transfer to UNCW.



## Schedule of Courses for the Nursing (BS) at UNCW

Students should apply to the NSG Program once they have completed the five minimum prerequisite courses and the TEAS. This is typically immediately after the freshman year in order to start the NSG Program in the sophomore year. The below sequence of courses assumes that the student waited an additional semester to apply to the NSG Program.
