The University of North Carolina at Wilmington **strongly recommends** students complete their Associate's degree prior to transferring to UNCW. Pathways are structured for students who have completed all requirements for their Associate's degree and qualify for the CAA. UNCW recommends that transfer students complete the Foreign Language Requirements prior to enrolling at UNCW.

<sup>6</sup>Communications (Required Courses); student can take COM 110, COM 120 or COM 231

<sup>7</sup>If student graduated high school more than 7 years ago or is taking a different language than studied in high school, they can take another course in the Global Awareness & FL category at the community college. If student graduated high school within last 7 years and is taking same language as high school or did not have at least two foreign language courses in high school, then they must take the same FL through 201 level at the CC or at UNCW. UNCW recommends that transfer students complete the Foreign Language Requirements prior to enrolling at UNCW. A student who chooses to wait on the FL requirement should consult with their advisor about satisfying the FL requirement at UNCW.

**THIS SHEET IS FOR ADVISING PURPOSES ONLY.** Students should work with their Advisor to determine course selections that will result in the greatest transferrable credit, for the intended program, upon transfer to the four-year school. Please remember that C-'s do not transfer to UNCW.

- Following the Pathway to Degree does not guarantee admission to UNCW or guarantee an AA degree or BA degree will be conferred.

- A conferred AA or AS degree will waive either the Living in a Diverse Nation OR Living in a Global Society requirement at UNCW. When meeting with their advisor, students should request that the Living in a Global Society requirement is waived for their Associate's degree, since the Living in a Diverse Nation requirement will be met via RTH 372 which is required for the Recreation Therapy major.
- Students will need to apply to UNCW as a transfer student (and be accepted) AND apply to the Recreation Therapy program (and be accepted) for their desired semester in order to follow the plan above.
- Priority Recreation Therapy application deadlines are 2/15 to start the following fall semester, and 9/15 to start the following spring semester. Students must be accepted into UNCW for the same semester that they are accepted to start the Recreation Therapy program.
- Recreation Therapy application requirements include: submitting an online RT application by the respective priority deadline, attaching a 2-3 page essay (information on the RT admissions page), and completing at least 50 direct contact hours of volunteer or work experience with individuals with disabilities, disabling conditions, or illnesses. Once the RT application is submitted, eligible applicants will then be invited for an interview with an RT faculty member.

- RTH 497 is a full-time internship in the final semester, and students are not allowed to take additional courses when they complete their internship. The RTH 497 internship will likely be outside of Wilmington due to a very limited number of local internship sites.
