This course teaches students about leadership and management in organizations. Class sessions are stimulating with many guest speakers from the nonprofit community; sessions with community leaders feature student networking and receptions. Students apply their learning in projects they complete for local nonprofit organizations during the summer. The skills students acquire in class — managing human resources, promoting and marketing, creating organizational mission and vision statements, etc. — are highly useful and transferable regardless of whether they decide to work in business, government, or a nonprofit. The course concludes with a Student Project Poster Session attended by members of the nonprofit and university communities.
