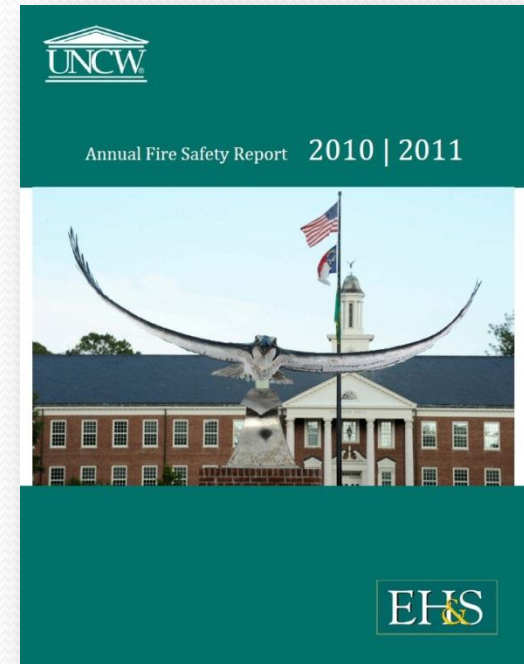

UNCW Campus Fire Safety Report

- Prepared by Environmental Health & Safety
- Applies to on campus housing facilities
- Requires reporting of building construction, fire protection systems, drills, regulations and training, improvements as well as actual fires
- Major accomplishments
 - All residence halls now have fire sprinklers (Schwartz & Suites summer 2011)
 - Memorandum of Understanding with Wilmington Fire Department to work together on training, education and planning
 - Increased education efforts to include videos
