



“String Saves” FAQ

Q: What are “String Saves”?

A: They allow you to extend the distance on any putt to reach the hole, saving you a stroke.

EX: Your team putts for birdie and ends up 4 inches short of the hole. You can now use 4 inches of your “String Save” to extend the putt and make birdie!

Q: Can I use “String Saves” on any shot?

A: No, “String Saves” can only be used on putts. Putts from the fairway, fringe, or green are eligible for “String Saves”.

Q: How much do “String Saves” cost?

A: “String Saves” are sold by the foot (1-12 inch piece) for \$10 per foot.

Q: How many feet can each player buy?

A: Players can buy and use any amount for themselves or their team.

Q: When can I buy “String Saves”?

A: “String Saves” are on sale prior to teeing off only. No string will be sold once the event starts.

Q: How do I track how much string I have used?

A: Team captains are given a marker to color in used sections of their “String Saves”. The string used is marked by coloring at the end point of the used string.

Q: Do “String Saves” really help my team?

A: Yes! If your team misses their putt, “String Saves” keep you from adding a stroke to your score. If your team misses 4 birdie putts during the day, “String Saves” let you make 4 birdies!
