"An Exploration of the Easy Breather Therapy Table for the Management of COPD Using Healthy Volunteers" (Analysis).

Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) is a set of progressive lung diseases including emphysema and chronic bronchitis that poses a significant threat to public health, as currently there is no cure available. Alternative therapeutic approaches, such as yoga and meditation, are attractive as traditional treatments are invasive and medications have side effects. Because of the gap in available efficacious treatments, a device was invented locally for the purpose of helping patients with COPD facilitate breathing. Therefore, the purpose of this study is to test the feasibility of this device (i.e., The Easy Breather Therapy Table) in a lab setting before it is distributed and used in home environments by patients with COPD.

"Clinical Research Simulation" (On-Going).

Research into applying clinical simulation (physical and virtual) to clinical research scenarios as an instructional aid for students, professionals, and service for external companies. Goal is to develop and test a modular framework of simulation that incorporates role-playing, video, software systems, and the principles of gamification.

"Competency Index for Clinical Research Professionals (CICRP): Measuring Competence of CoAPCR Students" (On-Going).

A research study that aims to measure the utility of a new competency index called the Competency Index for Clinical Research Professionals (CICRP). The primary purpose of the study is to determine the utility of this index to estimate acquisition of competence and readiness for clinical research certification exams for professional associations (e.g., Society of Clinical Research Associates and/or Association of Clinical Research Professionals) in participants who are nearing graduation or recently graduated from an academic program in clinical research. The CICRP index was developed based on a factor analysis of survey data from the Joint Task Force for Clinical Research Core Competencies, using responses from study coordinators, data managers, research managers and regulatory affairs professionals. This index aims to estimate perceptions of self-efficacy in clinical research competencies; primarily for non-investigator clinical research personnel.

"Development of a mobile app for clinical trial subject screening" (Planning).

Development of a MS in Clinical Research capstone project from Emily Edwards from proof

of concept and prototype mobile app to full functioning app that allows screening of potential clinical trial subjects against the inclusion and exclusion criteria of a protocol.

"Perceptions and Self-efficacy Towards Clinical Research" (Writing Results).

It is important that potentially future professionals in the clinical research industry understand their field of work in order to get the right people to the right job. The clinical research industry is expected to grow thereby providing employment opportunities for recent graduates of clinical research degree programs as experienced, entry-level employees. However, it is unclear how well students understand the industry they are planning to enter. Student understanding of this field may be built on presumptions, assumptions, and misconceptions. Such factors may misinform student decision-making about academic pursuits and job-seeking. I hypothesize that a student's understanding of clinical research industry influences performance of the student in the academic program, initial hiring, and career. The delivery of innovative products is resource dependent so improving the resource expertise may contribute to the productivity of the clinical research industry.

The clinical research commercialization effort seeks to evaluate commercialization potential for software tools for development of clinical research professionals. The project will research the utilization of an in-development product for clinical research professional development. Second, the project will research methods and instruments for assessment and ranking of clinical research professionals. The project will involve students and faculty in the UNCW Clinical Research Program with the UNCW Center for Innovation and Entrepreneurship-based startup, CRA360.
