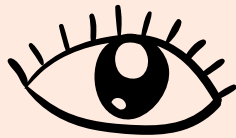
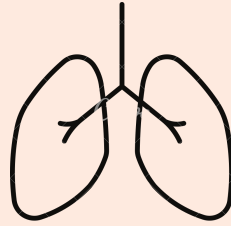

skin, nails, & lips



Limp body
Pale, clammy face



Choking sounds
Snore-like gurgling
Vomiting

- HOW TO RESPOND •

Act Immediately.
Call 911.
