

# NCAE-FTA SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

## The Applicant **MUST**:

- 1) Be an active member in good standing with a local FTA organization.
- 1) Be a North Carolina resident and a high school senior in with at least a GPA of 3.0.
- 2) Be planning to major in education.
- 3) Attend an in-state or out-of-state college or university.
- 4) Submit the following in one package by mail postmarked no later than **January 16, 2009**:
  - a. Copy of transcript in sealed envelope with school stamp.
  - b. Completed application form.
  - c. Three official recommendations
    - One FTA Advisor
    - One from another High School Teacher
    - One other (an Administrator, Community Representative, etc.)

**\*\* *Relatives should not be used for reference***
- 5) Be available for an interview by a screening committee on **February 7 or February 28, 2009** with the location to be determined according to applicants who reach the interview level.

**\*\* NCAE-FTA Scholarship winner is encouraged to decline our scholarship if he/she later becomes the recipient of a fully-funded scholarship from another source.**

## **Procedure**

- 6) Print the Scholarship Application to complete. Mail the completed application, along with all required documents, postmarked no later than **January 16, 2009** to:
