

JANE R. HANSEL TEACHER CADET SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Applicant MUST:

- 1) Be a senior in good standing with an un-weighted minimum GPA of 3.0.
- 2) Be planning to major in education.
- 3) Attend a college or university in North Carolina.
- 4) Be a NC Teacher Cadet who has completed the NC Teacher Cadet Program or will by the end of their senior year, and be in good standing.
- 5) Submit the following in one package by mail postmarked no later than **January 18, 2008**:
 - a. Copy of transcript in sealed envelope with school stamp.
 - b. Completed application form.
 - c. Four official recommendations
 - i) One from Teacher Cadet Teacher
 - ii) Three from other sources, such as:
 - the field experience cooperating teacher
 - another high school teacher
 - an administrator
 - community representative
- 6) Be available for an interview by a screening committee on **February 9 or February 23, 2008** with the location to be determined according to applicants who reach the interview level.

** Jane R. Hansel Scholarship winner is encouraged to decline our scholarship if he/she later becomes the recipient of a fully-funded scholarship from another source.

Procedure

- 1) Print the Scholarship Application to complete. Mail the completed application, along with all required documents, postmarked no later than **January 18, 2008** to:

Disbursement Procedure: A check will be sent to the institution for half the amount in the fall and a like check in the spring semester. If the recipient does not register, the check will be returned to the Teacher Cadet business office.

LETTERS OF REFERENCE AND TRANSCRIPT FROM HIGH SCHOOL

A Teacher Cadet applicant must attach at least four letters of reference in support of an application for the Teacher Cadet Scholarship and a sealed transcript in a school-stamped envelope. One letter should be from the Teacher Cadet Teacher that taught you the course or a supervisor of field experience. (Relatives should not be used for references.)
