

Motion for University Studies distinction between upper and lower division requirements

As General Administration requires that all UNC campuses distinguish between lower and upper-division general studies courses, we resolve that the following language be added to the Catalog regarding which of the University Studies requirements are considered lower-division versus upper-division.

Lower Division

All **Foundations**, but note that Lifetime Wellness and the Foreign Language requirement are exempted from the CAA.

All **Approaches and Perspectives** except 3 credits of Living in Our Global Society or Living in Our Diverse Nation.

3 credits of **QLR**

3 out of 9 **Writing Intensive** credits.

3 out of 9 **Information Literacy** credits.

Lifetime Wellness (2 hours)

Foreign Language requirement (Proficiency at the 201 level (or higher) in a language previously studied or 2 semesters 101-102 in a new language)

Upper Division

3 credits of Living in Our Global Society or Living in Our Diverse Nation.

6 credits of **WI**.

6 credits of **IL**.

1 **EBC**-approved experience.

3 credits of **Capstone**.

Transdisciplinary Thematic Clusters

Many CAA-eligible students would have satisfied 2 out of 3 courses in a cluster. *However, a student's need to fulfill this requirement is contingent upon the student's choice of major and/or minor. In addition, specific cluster requirements would be established once transfer credit has been evaluated.*
