

Directions to Film Studies Department:

The Film Studies department offices and auditorium are located in King Hall, on the north corner of the UNCW campus. Our building is between the Fisher Student Center and Randall Library, near the campus commons ponds and amphitheatre.

To drive directly to King Hall:

- Enter campus on Randall Drive, then take the first right on to Wagoner Drive – the road that skirts the front edge of UNCW parallel to South College Road).
- Drive past Kenan Auditorium and continue on Wagoner Drive for approximately one block, until you come to a parking lot marked with a street sign reading Alumni Drive. Turn left on Alumni Drive.
- Turn left onto the access/parking road skirting Kenan Hall and follow that road around Kenan Hall and back to a small parking area between Randall Library and King Hall. Parking spots on this option are open to the public only after 5 pm.

Other Parking Options:

A large visitor parking lot is located on Riegel Road, less than a five minute walk from King Hall. To access this lot, enter campus from South College Road onto Hurst Drive, on UNCW's West corner (near Cook Out). Follow Hurst Drive to the first traffic light and take a left onto Hamilton Drive. Follow Hamilton Drive for approximately one block and take the first right onto Riegel Road. Lot M, the visitor parking lot, will be on your left just past Price Drive.

After 5 pm, public parking is available in lot E, which is between Fisher Student Center and King Hall. To access lot E, enter campus from South College Road onto Hurst Drive, on UNCW's West corner (near Cook Out). Follow Hurst Drive to the first traffic light and take a left onto Hamilton Drive. Continue on Hamilton Drive past Reigel road; Hamilton will take you directly to Lot E.
