



CRRSAA: Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF II) Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

Quarterly Report
September 30, 2021

1. The University of North Carolina at Wilmington has accepted from the Department the Certification and Supplemental Agreement for the award increase dated 1/17/2021. We intend to use the additional \$5,283,027 funds received under Section 314 (a)(1) HEERF II of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. The University of North Carolina at Wilmington has received \$5,283,027 from the Department pursuant to our Certification and Agreement for HEERF II (CRRSAA) Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students. The total received for HEERF I (CARES) and HEERF II (CRRSAA) Emergency Financial Aid Grants is \$10,566,054.
3. The total amount of HEERF II (CRRSAA) Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students as of September 30, 2021 is \$5,283,027. The total amount of both HEERF I (CARES) and HEERF II (CRRSAA) Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students as of September 30, 2021 is \$10,566,054.
4. As of the Spring 2021 semester, the estimated total number of students at the University of North Carolina at Wilmington eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 314 (a)(1) of HEERF II (CRRSAA) is approximately 13,000.
5. The total number of students at the University of North Carolina at Wilmington who have received a HEERF II (CRRSAA) Emergency Financial Aid Grant as of September 30, 2021 is 7,402.
6. The method used by the University of North Carolina at Wilmington to determine which students receive HEERF II (CRRSAA) Emergency Financial Aid Grants was constructed on a block format ranging from \$300-\$900 based on financial need as measured by the FAFSA.

Once block aid was disbursed the remaining \$127,794 was used to assist students with special circumstances as determined through an application process.

7. The University notified all students by the website on February 15, 2021 and email on February 16, 2021 regarding information about the HEERF II (CRRSAA) Emergency Grants. Prior to block grant disbursements each recipient was notified of award via email.

Remaining HEERF II (CRRSAA) Emergency Grant funds were used to support special circumstances awards in August 2021. Postcards were mailed to registered students on August 2, 2021 and an email communication was sent to all students on August 12, 2021.
