



ARP Act: Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III (HEERF III) Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

Quarterly Report
June 30, 2021

1. The University of North Carolina at Wilmington has accepted from the Department the Certification and Supplemental Agreement for the award increase dated 5/24/2021. We intend to use the additional \$15,154,349 funds received under Section 314 (a)(1) HEERF III of the American Rescue Plan Act, 2021 (ARP) to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. The University of North Carolina at Wilmington has received \$15,154,349 from the Department pursuant to our Certification and Agreement for HEERF III (ARP) Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students. The total received for HEERF I (CARES), HEERF II (CRRSAA), and HEERF III (ARP) Emergency Financial Aid Grants is \$25,720,403.
3. The total amount of HEERF III (ARP) Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students as of June 30, 2021 is \$8,327,500. The total amount for HEERF I (CARES), HEERF II (CRRSAA), and HEERF III (ARP) Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students as of June 30, 2021 is \$18,765,760.
4. As of the Spring 2021 semester, the estimated total number of students at the University of North Carolina at Wilmington eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 314 (a)(1) of HEERF III (ARP) is approximately 13,000.
5. The total number of students at the University of North Carolina at Wilmington who have received a HEERF III (ARP) Emergency Financial Aid Grant as of June 30, 2021 is 4,971.
6. The method used by the University of North Carolina at Wilmington to determine which students receive HEERF III (ARP) Emergency Financial Aid Grants was allocated in a block format ranging from \$1,000-\$3,000 based on FAFSA gross need (as measured by Expected Family Contribution). Identified non-citizens received \$1,000 as need could not be evaluated from a FAFSA.
7. The University notified students as they were identified as eligible for HEERF III (ARP) Emergency Grants based on registration and need. One email notification was sent to students on June 14, 2021 for funds processed to student accounts by fiscal year end June 30. A second round of award notifications were emailed to students on June 30 to be processed in July.
