Financial aid packages for 2019-2020 will be prepared after the spring semester grades are posted and finalized. Students may continue to work towards completing program requirements until the last day of the semester, May 9th. All students will receive communication regarding their status in the program for next year by May 13th. Students that do not advance in the program because of a GPA or credit hour deficiency may opt to attend summer school as a means of raising the GPA or obtaining the necessary 30 credit hours. Students should consult with their academic advisor to determine the course grade (s) needed to positively impact the GPA to meet the 3.5 requirement. By completing the FAFSA early, students that do not advance may still receive institutional grant aid.
