## SUMMER SCHOOL

The application for summer aid is open. Funds are awarded to students in the order that the summer aid application is received until the funds are exhausted. Students may enroll in traditional, seated classes at UNCW, online courses at UNCW, online courses at another university, or a community college at home. In either scenario, financial aid is available to minimize the out of pocket costs. Students must earn 30 hours each academic year and a GPA of 3.5 as part of the requirements to advance in the next academic year. All summer coursework can help a student earn the 30 credit hours; only courses offered by UNCW can impact a student's GPA.
