## **GRADUATION**

A student must have no less than a 3.0 GPA on all graduate-level courses. **Three grades of C, one grade of F, or one grade of U (thesis)** results in ineligibility for graduation. Grades of A,B,C,F,S,U and W are permanent grades and can be changed only by the instructor with the approval of the appropriate dean in cases of arithmetical or clerical error or as a result of protest of grade.
