### Returning to Campus - LOVE WHERE YOU LIVE!

Greetings, Seahawk! We are thrilled that you will be living with us this year! We compiled everything you need to know to return to campus and check into your residential community.

**Returning and transfer students** (*sophomores, juniors, seniors and graduate students*) living in **Loggerhead Hall, Terrapin Hall, Seahawk Crossing, Seahawk Landing, Seahawk Village or University Suites** are permitted to return to campus, and check into their fall housing assignment between the hours of **8am – 4pm** on:

**SUNDAY, August 21<sup>st</sup> – Tuesday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>**

**Please note that we will not be able to accommodate returning students arriving to campus until these dates; your room key will not be available for pick up until August 21<sup>st</sup>.** Please bring a valid proof of identification, such as your license, state ID, military ID or passport and your medical insurance card to complete the check-in process at the front desk or lobby of your assigned residence hall.

**Unlike years past, we are welcoming 2,700 returning residents back to campus in a consolidated period ahead of the First Day of Classes for fall 2022. Therefore, your return to campus and the subsequent logistics of your arrival have been coordinated to ensure your process is as efficient as possible. To this end, returning students will need to sign up for an arrival time. It is important that you arrive, check in and unload your belongings during your designated window.
