

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service requires that UNCW have written proof that an applicant has sufficient funds to pay all expenses while studying in the U.S.A before a form I-20 can be issued.

Financial Information and Certification of Availability for Funds for Study

If parent or self will financially support the student, complete Box One. If the student will be financially supported by someone other than parent or self, complete Box Two and include a letter in English from that organization or individual sponsor stating that tuition, fees, and living expenses will be provided to the student while he or she studies at UNCW. The individual sponsor's financial statement from the bank must be included.

I understand that I must pay for the ESL program at UNCW (tuition, fees, room and board, and medical insurance), and have access to funds which will be available and will be provided as required.
