Hours/Schedule: The purpose of this agreement is to cover research that does not pertain to your thesis. Generally, this means hours dedicated to activities that contribute to the overall research in a lab other than your thesis.

Research agreements are required for any research/lab activities/meetings other than thesis-related work, including over the summer and during school breaks, if the student is paid, volunteering, or unpaid. This agreement should be amended if other non-thesis duties arise that are not included in this agreement.
