**Core Courses** are: **PSY 510** Cognitive; **PSY 517** Learning; **PSY 520** Developmental; **PSY 556** Adv. Physiological; and **PSY 565** Social & Personality.

**Research Credits:** master's students must take PSY 579 in their first semester and PSY 580 in their second semester. They also must complete a total of 6 thesis credits (PSY 599), with a max of 5 in any semester. Students must have defended their prospectus by the end of drop/add in the Fall semester of their second year and have a grade in Psy 580 to enroll in thesis credits in a given semester.

**PSYSSCI students** (with thesis mentor approval) choose 4 of the 5 core courses and can take more than 1 core class in a semester. They must take one elective at the 500-level or higher approved by the Grad Coordinator. This elective can be taken during any semester and can be another Core class, another Psychology graduate course, or a graduate course in another department. Students can take more graduate courses than are required.

**ABA students** are expected to participate in a weekly advanced-topics seminar (PSY 522) each semester. They cannot register for the practicum course (PSY 593) in Spring Year 2 if they are not in good standing in the department. After Spring Year 2 and after they have defended their thesis, they complete a 3 credit hour/1000 work hour Internship (PSY 597). The credit hours are spread across semesters as necessary.
