Faculty SeaNet Access Change

As we wind up the spring semester, I wanted to make you aware of a compliance change that will happen on May 13. To conform to Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) guidance concerning “school officials with legitimate educational interests”, we are removing certain faculty access only for those faculty who are not in an academic advisor role. Faculty who are teaching, with no advisor responsibilities, should not be privy to certain student information determined to be non-essential to her/his instructional responsibilities.

The primary and most noticeable change is that faculty (without advisor roles) will lose access to the SeaNet Advisor Menu. This menu has been previously available to faculty and contained more student information than was necessary to perform their instructional responsibilities. I will be sending a list of current advisors (from Banner) to Associate Deans before May 13, to ensure that advisor roles are correctly recorded to minimize the effects of this change.
