


How to Run a Degree Audit

A Degree Audit is a web-based tool to help students and advisors monitor progress towards degree completion.

1. Log in to SeaNet

2. Click on "Student Services & Financial Aid"



- Military Status for Financial Aid and Residency Determination**: Military Affiliation Verification (required)
- Request Excused Absence**: Request Excused Absence
- Fixed Tuition Information**: UNC Fixed Tuition
