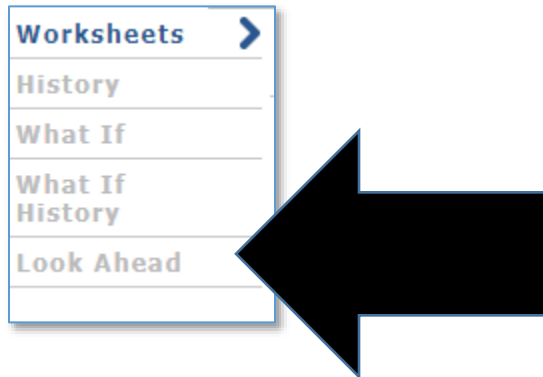


How to Use the Look Ahead Feature

The Look Ahead Feature allows students to see an audit showing courses for which you plan to register in future terms.

1. On the left navigation of the Degree Audit, click on Look Ahead Feature. The Look Ahead Feature allows students to see an audit showing courses for which you plan to register in future terms.



2. Enter course names and numbers. You can add several courses to the list. Start with Subject and use course abbreviation such as PSY for Psychology.


