Residency Determination Service

On February 20, the UNC campuses will transition to a centralized residency determination service for tuition purposes. No longer will students have to submit hundreds of pages of documentation to make their case for in-state residency for tuition purposes. Students will be able to request a determination online. The online process will verify against 70+ local, state, and federal databases rendering a decision within minutes. Students will receive a decision along with a residency certification number (RCN). That number can be used to identify their residency status at any higher education institution in the state. UNC, NC Community College, and private institutions (for NC Tuition Grant) will utilize this new online determination. More information will be provided at our February Registrar fora.
