Residency Determination Service

On February 20, the UNC campuses transitioned to a centralized residency determination service for tuition purposes. No longer will students have to submit hundreds of pages of documentation to make their case for in-state residency for tuition purposes. Students will be able to request a determination online. Once the process is complete, the students will receive a decision along with a residency certification number (RCN). That number can be used to identify their residency status at any higher education institution in the state.
