**“MY VARIABLE IS BIGGER THAN YOUR VARIABLE:

Is it income inequality or poverty that accounts for variation in homicide victimization across nations? The findings suggest that we must reassess the strong conclusions regarding the income inequality- and poverty- homicide theses and continue to explore human poverty as a viable alternative to the ongoing debate.
