Welcome to University Testing Services (UTS)! UTS provides secure computer-based and paper-based testing and test proctoring services for UNCW and the surrounding communities. Through quality and professional facilities and services, the staff strives to offer a testing experience that is fair, efficient, and accessible. Admissions and certification testing programs as well as proctoring services for online courses are available through University Testing Services. Generally, services provided in the Testing Center are by appointment and require payment in advance. Valid photo identification with a signature is always required.

MISSION

The mission of University Testing Services is to provide secure, professional and efficient testing services to UNCW and surrounding communities. In support of the academic mission, high quality testing and assessment related services are provided for various needs which include the evaluation of knowledge and skills, the assessment of learning outcomes, achieving educational goals and securing professional certifications. University Testing Services practices and promotes fairness in testing procedures for all testing candidates. We adhere to the National College Testing Association (NCTA) Professional Standards and Guidelines.

COMPUTER-BASED TESTING SERVICES

In cooperation with the Educational Testing Services (ETS) and campus departments, a number of testing programs are available via computer. Each program has specific requirements and fees. Available admissions, certification and credit-earning programs include:

PAPER-BASED TESTING SERVICES

(National programs-Saturday only)

In support of the admissions process, a limited number of paper-based programs are also offered. These programs are available only in a paper-based format, require pre-registration through a national testing program/company and are offered primarily on Saturdays.

- LSAT: Law School Admissions Test
